Methodist Episcopal Churches

The Gardnertown Methodist Episcopal Church in 1825, the old "George Stanton's class", was organized into a church and on Dec. 15, Burroughs Westlake, Joshua Marston, David W. Gidney, Silas B. Gardner and Robert Lockwood were chosen "Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church at Gardnertown". A suitable edifice was erected the same year and was dedicated on the 20th of November. A new church was built by the society in 1858 and dedicated November 24th. The cost of the new church was \$2750. The society was still being supplied by circuit Preachers and with the societies at Rossville and Galeville were formed into the "West Newburgh and Galeville circuit".

Grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part and their successors,

ALL that certain triangular lot, piece or parcel of land situated at Gardnertown in said town of Newburgh. Beginning at a point in the middle of new road leading from Gardnertown to Rocky Forest 10 feet north of the extension of the line of the north end of the Church of Gardnertown and running thence south-westerly parallel with the said north line of said church three hundred and twenty feet to the southerly side of the road leading to the Big Pond; thence along the southerly side of the said road easterly three hundred and eighty feet to the center of the said first mentioned road; thence northerly along the middle of the same two hundred six feet to the place of beginning.

(0.562 ACRES)
Containing about 90 rods of land more or less.

Upon the express condition nevertheless that the said lands and premises to be used for and occupied expressly as a place of public christian worship, forever. And in case the said premises be appropriated to or for any other purposes whatsoever then the same are to revert to the said John H. Bond, his heirs or assigns.

Bond and Louisa Bond and the survivors of them and the parties of the first part herein, said Mary Elizabeth Bond and Louisa Bond are the surviving daughters of said John H. Bond, deceased.

LOCATING A GRAVE

To help you locate a grave in the cemetery, first look up the person's name. A number is next to the name, (stone #). Go to the list of numbered headstones and locate your stone. See what section your stone is located in.

I've divided the cemetery into four sections, front right, (1-17), front left, (18-84), back right, (85-125), and back left, (126-154).

The front and back section division line is a natural line in the cemetery located as you walk through the gate. The left and right sections are as if you stand in the front center of the cemetery, Union Ave. side, and look toward the back. This will give you a general location of the grave.

I have located approximately 182 headstones and 265 names.
